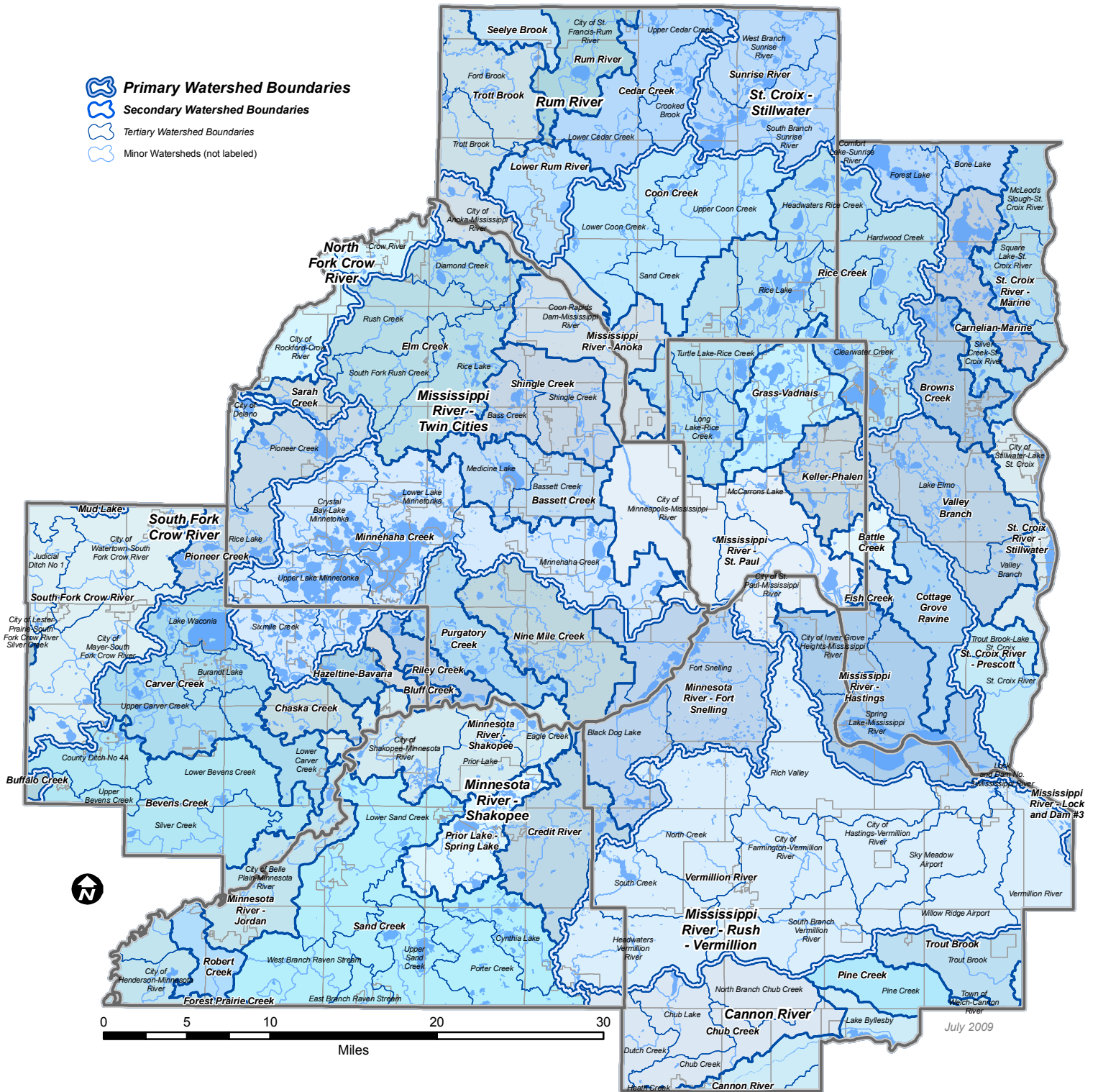


Twin Cities Metropolitan Area Watersheds

Minnesota DNR Level 08 Catchments



Minnesota DNR Catchments are the smallest delineated and digitized drainage areamapped by the DNR Watershed Delineation Project. As the lowest Hydrologic Unit Level of the DNR watershed hierarchal system and the foundation of all other Minnesota DNR watershed datasets, these catchment delineations coupled with GIS tool are applicable to projects from small to large scales. The DNR Catchment delineations share coincident boundaries that aggregate together to define Minnesota DNR Basin Watersheds, Minnesota DNR Minor Watersheds and Minnesota DNR Major Watersheds

This product represents many major drainage boundary changes from data that the Metropolitan Council had been using for many years. The Metropolitan Council appended to the Catchment data attributes from its own watershed file regarding primary and secondary identification and coding which is reflected in the current classification scheme.
